- U9s & 10'S- 7 v 7 with 3 substitutes maximum of 10 players per team
- Inc Goalkeeper
- U11'S & 12'S – 9 v 9 with 3 substitutes maximum number of 12 players per team - Inc Goalkeeper
- JR Girls (11 to 13 Yr) – 7 v 7 with 2 substitutes maximum number of 9 per team - Inc Goalkeeper

All players must be registered with their affiliated association.

Closing date for nominations is **Saturday 15th August 2009.**

Carnival Entry Fees to be paid on or before day:

- Under 6 - \$40.00
- Under 7 to 10s and Girls - \$50.00
- Under 11 & 12s - \$65.00

RULES FOR JUNIOR CARNIVAL

All coaches, team managers and parents please note the following: -

1. Registration and completed teamlist must be submitted by 9.00am.
2. A player cannot play in more than one team during the carnival.
3. A player cannot play down into a team of an age group lower than their own age.
4. Players per team:
 - U6's - 4 v 4 with 2 substitutes maximum of 6 players per team
- no goalkeeper
 - U7's & 8's - 5 v 5 with 3 substitutes maximum of 8 players per team
- no goalkeeper
 - U9s & 10's- 7 v 7 with 3 substitutes maximum of 10 players per team
- inc goalkeeper
 - U11's & 12's – 9 v 9 with 3 substitutes maximum number of 12 players per team - inc goalkeeper
 - Jr girls (11 to 13 yr) – 7 v 7 with 2 substitutes maximum number of 9 per team
- inc goalkeeper
5. Small sided game rules apply with no offside rule for all age groups.
6. All games will be 10 minutes each way with a straight turn around at half time. The hooter will signal start, half time and finish.

There will be a 5 minute break between each game.

7. If you miss the start of the game the game will be shortened to finish at the scheduled time.
8. If you do not have an official referee for your game please appoint someone to referee.
9. All completed score sheets are to be handed in at the registration desk by the winning team immediately after each game.
10. Results of games will be decided as follows: -
Win = 3 points draw = 1 point loss = 0 points

Teams to play in the finals will be determined on: -
A/ points b/ goal difference c/ play off match
11. Finals will be 10 minutes each way. If scores are level at the end of 20 minutes an extra 5 minutes each way will be played.
U6 to U10 will be declared joint winners if no score after extra time.
U11, U12 & Girls will play a further 5 minutes with the golden goal rule applying. If scores are still level a penalty shoot out will decide the winner.
All finals will be refereed by an independent person.
