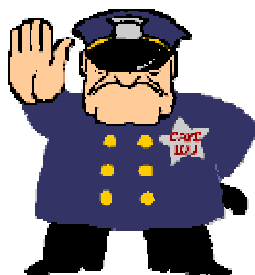
Sponsors...
